Senario 2- If the covid positive family member is asymptomatic

- The RTPCR test should be done between day 5 and day 7 from the day of positive test of family member.
- If the RTPCR test is positive home isolate
- if found negative continue working with adequate precautions

Senario 3- If the family member who is positive becomes symptomatic before day 7

- Then the RTPCR test is to be done immediately.
- If the RTPCR test is positive home isolate
- If found negative continue working with adequate precautions

Kindly note after the swab for RTPCR test is given one should remain in isolation till the test results of the RTPCR and act according to the report of RTPCR

The above instructions are to be shared with all the stake holders (teaching/non-teaching/PGs/Interns of the Institute) to prevent spread of Covid- 19 infection.
