- > Refill your existing dispensers of hand sanitizer as and when required from store as the institute has purchased 5 litre cans. Kindly ensure that existing dispensers are not discarded.
- Face shield is available for the staff members and PG students
- ➤ For the treatment of patients we plan the following: All PG students shall wear scrub suits in the clinics. The institute plans to provide surgical masks, surgical cloth gowns, sterile surgical gowns (disposable), foot covers, face shields, sanitiser, liquid soap and appropriate floor and surface disinfectants. Eyewear, N95 masks and scrub suits will be purchased by students.
- All departments (except Oral Pathology and OMR) to indent 25 disposable surgical gowns (Surgical Indent) immediately. These are to be used for aerosol generating procedures only. These gowns are to be over surgical gowns (green cloth).
