1. BDS admissions 2020-21:

First Round: Reporting of students were from 6th November to 16th November 2020 (**during Diwali holidays**)

Second Round: Reporting of students were from 28th November to 8th December 2020 85 out of 85 seats allotted in first round (one of the only colleges with 100% allocation) 81 seats retained (highest no. of retention of seats all over India)

2. First, Second & Third Year BDS University Examinations were conducted for I, II & III BDS from 21st November to 9th December 2020 maintaining 'Social Distancing' & standard sanitization norms. A meeting regarding this Examination (schedule and conduction) was conducted on 20th November 2020 & instructions were given for students who are appearing for University theory examination. Students were given clear instructions regarding the dress code, instruments required, journal submission and examination discipline. All Internal Examiners (Chairpersons) informed the day/s, date, time and venue of the Practical / Clinical Examinations to concerned students.

Staff communicated with those students who have not paid the Examination fees as their Examination forms have not been filled by college staff. The forms for all other students have been filled by the college staff and forwarded to the University for approval and preparation of Admit Cards.

All HoDs submitted Internal Assessment Marks of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd year BDS students (in the prescribed format) to the Administrative Office.

In view of the large number of students attending Practical Examinations, the students reported one hour before the scheduled time of the Examination to ensure proper evaluation of each and every candidate prior to commencement of the Examination. All students appearing for the University Examinations have undergone pre-examination evaluation (temperature and oxygen saturation) even if the examination was being held in the Medical College premises.

The Examination halls have been sanitized. Infrared thermometers & Pulse Oximeter are used on all individuals entering college premises. In addition spray machines have been used to sanitize corridors, lecture halls and clinics. Hand sanitizer have been provided to all students.

The Office Administration has made arrangements to ensure that the college remained open from 8.30am to 4.30 pm during the University Practical Examinations.
