
The Minutes of Core Committee held on **27/06/18** (Thursday) are presented herewith:

**Updates:**

1. Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology organized a programme on occasion of 'No Tobacco Day' on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019. Dr.Santosh Jadhav and Dr.Shameeka Thopate presented lectures on the ill effects of tobacco use. The interns presented a skit at the event .The Department of Public Health Dentistry also participated in the event.
2. Details of the furniture requirements from all the departments was compiled and sent to the head office.
3. A circular regarding pending fee of PG students was sent to departments to inform the concerned students.
4. Pending fee issue of the students (UG and PG) was discussed by Mr. Anil Kadam (O.S). He has requested all departments to remind students about the pending fee.
5. It was decided to consider application of late fee following approval of the University .It was decided to do identify students who have not paid fee after the first Sessional Examinations of every academic year and counsel them accordingly.
