- Dr. Amod Patankar PPT presentation of implant work carried out in the department of Oral Surgery, Periodontology and Prosthetics from April 2017.
- 2. Refund claims sorted. Ms. Anuja Ingle Rs. 7000 and Mr. Mahesh Jare Rs. 8000
- Only following Implant Companies shall provide implants from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019:
- A. Alpha Biotech

- H. Adin
- The implants from newly added Companies ( B & B, Cowelmedi, Adin ) shall be purchased from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019.
- Following implant companies have reduced their cost per unit as;
- A. Bredent: Rs. 8500
- B. Megagen: Rs. 6500
- c. B & B: Rs.8500
- 5. The **Revised Charges** applicable from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019 as:

- A. The entire cost (Surgical and Prosthetic phase) of the procedure shall be procured from patient prior to the commencement of treatment.
- B. The patient shall receive **two** separate receipts as follows:- For the **Implant** (Post Graduate student should write name of company of implant on reverse of the receipt and should take signature of the Staff and put stamp of the respective Department.)
- C. For the **Prosthesis**( Post Graduate student should write type of prosthesis, Laboratory on reverse of the receipt and should take signature of the Staff and put stamp of the respective Department.
- D. These receipts should be preserved by the patient and postgraduate student until the satisfactory conclusion of all the procedures.
- E. These two receipts/ or photocopy of receipts should also be submitted to Mr. Arvind Chinchwade in the Stores.

a. Charges for patients requiring for All On 4/5/6 Prosthesis per Arch:

- a. Surgical phase: Cost of 4/5/6 implants plus components( multiangle abutments, titanium cylinders, healing caps, implant analog, open tray transfer coping) + Rs.
   10000 per arch
- b. Prosthetic phase: cost of Lab work + Rs.10000 per arch.
- b. Patients with Special cases like Overdenture, Full mouth rehabilitation (only in cases in which amount is exceeding 50 Thousand) can pay in two installments with prior written permission of Head of the respective department and the Principal.
- c. The prize of laboratory charges of special cases (casting/ milling), cost of special screws, UCLA etc should be considered and discussed with the patient and staff member prior to commencement of the work.
- d. Labs available for dental implant prosthesis are: Katara Dental lab, Dent care, Poona Dental Lab and Shivam Lab.
- e. Cost of X-rays, CBCT, models etc shall be borne by the Patient.
- f. Cost of the impression post (open tray/closed tray), implant analog etc. should be borne by the operating postgraduate student.
- g. All the completed Prosthesis from all the Laboratories shall be delivered to Mr. Arvind Chinchawade (stores). Post Graduate students shall collect the Prosthesis for delivery to patients after showing the receipts of payment.
